## Some Things You may Want to Pack

## For Labor:

- G Your health insurance card, ID, and hospital registration forms
- G Lotion or Oil for Labor massage
- G A picture or a treasured object to use as a focal point during contractions
- G An old nightgown or nightshirt (if you don't want to wear a hospital gown)
- G A pillow from home
- *G A bathrobe*
- G Slippers
- G Socks
- G A barrette or band to tie back your hair
- G Glasses, if you wear them (you may not be allowed to wear contact lenses during labor)
- G A cassette or CD player and some soothing music
- G A camera with fully charged batteries, if you plan to take pictures

## For Your Hospital Stay:

- G Two or three nightgowns (be sure the gowns open in the front if your plan to nurse)
- G Two or three nursing bras and a dozen or so nursing pads
- G A few pair of socks
- G Sanitary pads
- G Shampoo
- G Lotion, deodorant, lip balm, and other toiletry items
- G A hair brush or comb
- G Barrettes or hair ties
- G Contact lenses (if you wear them)
- G A notepad and pencil
- G A long distance calling card
- G Phone numbers of people you want to call after birth
- G Magazines or other reading material
- G A baby book
- G A receiving blanket and clothes for your newborn to wear home
- G Loose-fitting clothes for you to wear home
- G A car seat for your baby
